

# 5 IMPACT ZONES

## INSTITUTIONAL

Cultivating institutional peace refers to how we incorporate the values, principles and norms of equity and justice into the systemic structures that moderate human affairs.



## POLITICAL

Cultivating political peace requires that we actively strive to establish just, nonviolent procedures for organizing, making and implementing policy and planning decisions at all levels of social organization.



## INTERNAL

Cultivating internal peace refers to the discovery of one's purpose, power and potential (authentic self) as we actively strive to establish right relationship with others by first overcoming our own fear and trauma.

## ENVIRONMENTAL

Cultivating environmental peace requires that we actively strive to establish right relationships with Earth and its ecosystems of which we are a part, and on which our survival and quality of life depend.



## SOCIAL

Cultivating social peace refers to how we manage our interpersonal conflicts and differences, and how we give to and receive from others the qualities and conditions that express human dignity.
